DIRECTIONS

St. Jacob Mission is located in on Vermont Route 12 in Northfield Falls, VT, 10 minutes south of Montpelier.

From the north --Take I-89, Exit 8

From Exit 8, follow the signs for VT Rte 12-South. After several traffic lights, VT Rte 12-South turns right (approx. 1.3 miles from Exit 8). After the right turn, follow VT Rte 12-South approximately 8.3 additional miles to Northfield Falls. The Church is on the left hand side.

From the south --Take I-89 Exit 5

From Exit 5, follow off-ramp down the hill to Northfield. At the bottom of the hill (approx. 2.8 miles from Exit 5), turn right on VT Rte 12-North. Follow VT Rte 12-North approximately 3.7 additional miles, past Norwich University and through Northfield to Northfield Falls. The Church is on the right hand side.
